

Cycle of Life









































Passport to Learning



The 5 Golden Rules:

Learning must be voluntary

Learning must be out of school hours

There must be structured learning taking place

Pupils can gain no more than 10 credits per activity per term

All passport credits must be gained at a validated Learning destination. Passports will be stamped, not signed!
