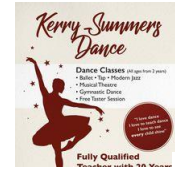

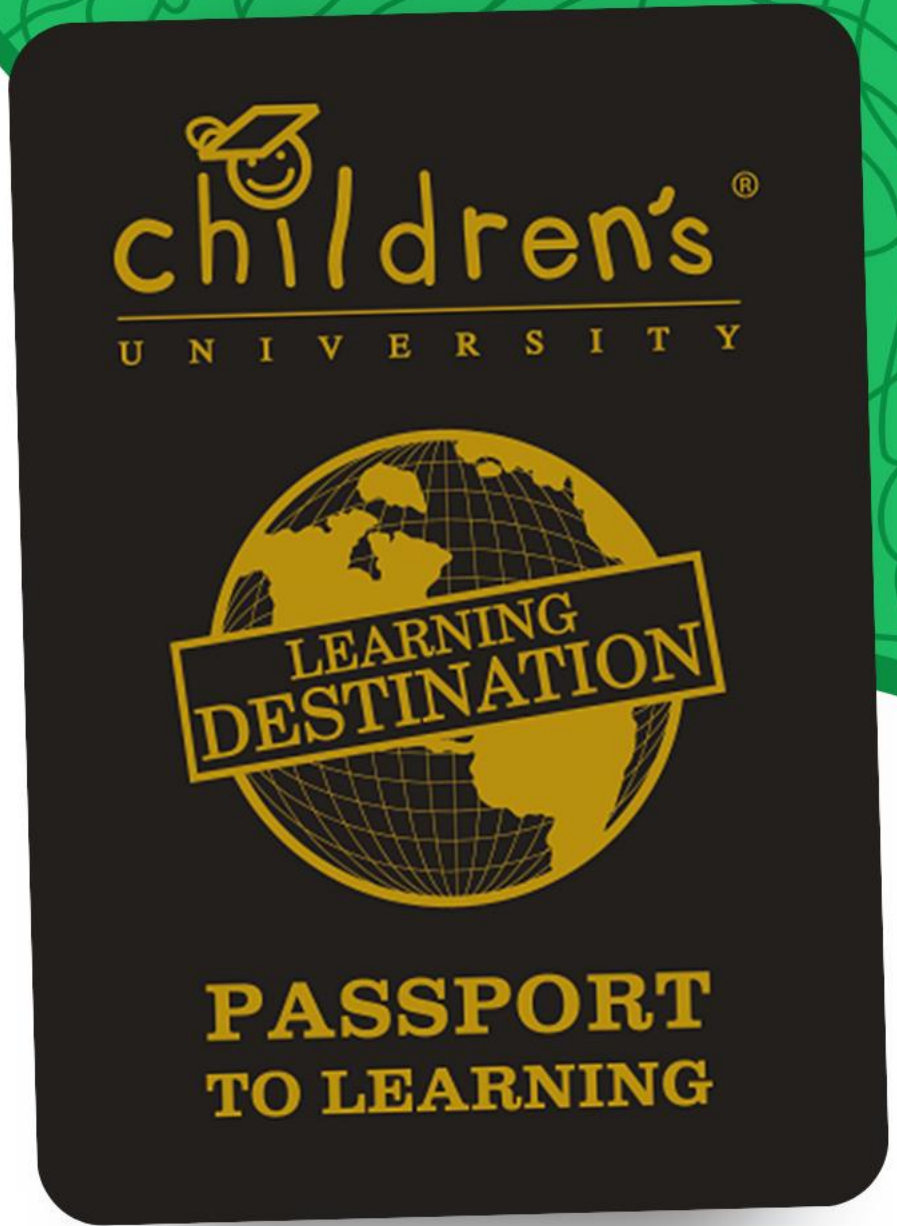
Passport to Learning

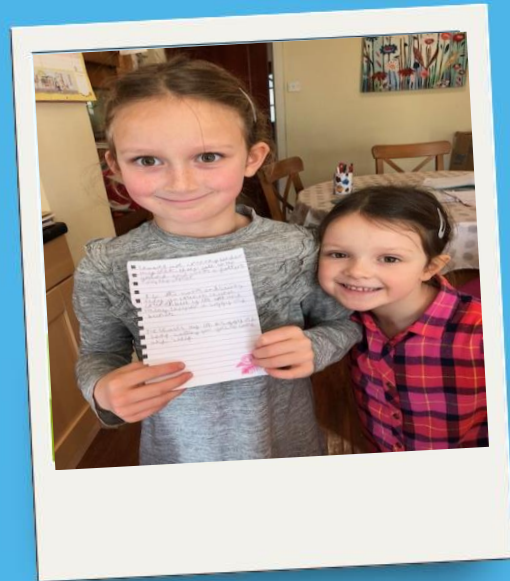
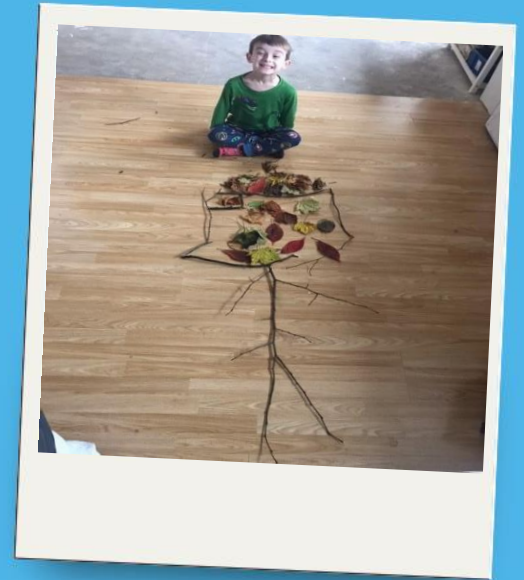
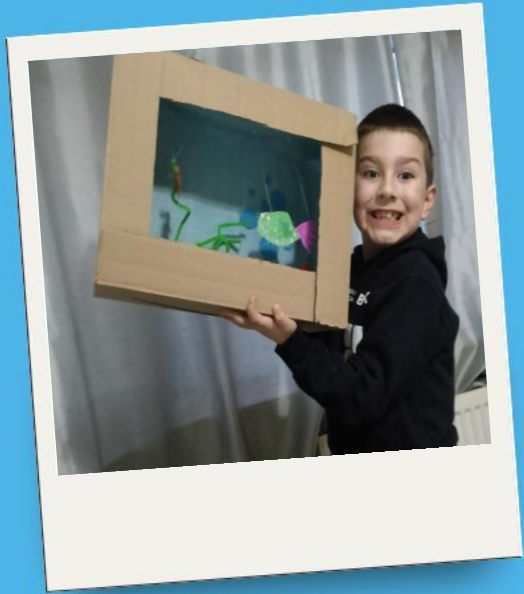
