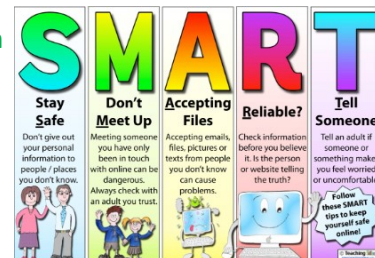

THIS WEEK IN PSHE

This week in Phonics

This week in Phonics, Year 1 have been revising Phase 3 sounds.

We have looked at:

'oi' - coin, soil, tinfoil

'ear' - clear, fear, tear

'air' - pair, fair, stairs

'ure' - mature, cure, lure

'oi' contains two letters and is known as a digraph.

'ear', 'air' and 'ure' contain three letters and are known as trigraphs.
